## Protect Yourself Against Breast and Cervical Cancer

Breast Cancer is the most common cancer in women. Early detection gives a woman her best chance of survival.

There are no warning signs for cervical cancer. But cervical cancer can be successfully prevented and treated if detected early.

## FREE Screening in Anne Arundel County

You can receive free Breast Exams, Mammograms, and Pap Tests through the Anne Arundel County Department of Health's Breast and Cervical Cancer Program. Eligible women receive coupons for free care. A network of highly skilled, private county health care providers honor these coupons.

## Two Simple Tests

A Mammogram and a Cervical Cancer Screening can detect cancer in early treatable stages.

## What is a Mammogram?

A Mammogram is an X-ray picture of the breasts. Mammograms detect tumors that cannot be found by a breast exam. A Mammogram is slightly uncomfortable for some women... but it can save your life!

## What is a Pap Test?

A Pap Test is a cervical screening performed in your doctor's office. A small piece of your cervical tissue is taken during an internal exam and is tested to see if there is anything unusual about the cells in the tissue. A Pap Test is slightly uncomfortable for some women... but it can save your life!
