

Instructions for Completing the Application to Conduct an Open Fire

- 1. **Property:** Provide the street address, city, state, ZIP code and property tax account number (from your property tax bill) for the property where the open fire is to be conducted.
- **2. Distance:** Provide distance to nearest occupied dwelling, and the distance to nearest public road and the name of that road for the property where the open fire is to be conducted.
- 3. **Purpose:** Indicate whether the open fire is for demolition, land clearing, agriculture, recreational or other purposes.

If it is a recreational fire that includes the burning of untreated wood for pleasure, religious, ceremonial, cooking or a bonfire, you must provide the date and the type of event. For example: Halloween bonfire on October 31, 2017. Recreational fires with a volume of less than one cubic yard (e.g. 3' x 3' x 3') do not require a license.

If a request is made to waive the required 1,500-foot buffer to an occupied dwelling or a primary road, you must indicate why.

Example 1: Request a waiver to burn at 600 feet with the aid of a pit and an Air Curtain Destructor (ACD).

Example 2: Request a waiver for agricultural, land, water or forestry management purposes.

You must submit a letter from the appropriate authority recommending the burning as an accepted management practice in agriculture or land, water or forestry management. Examples: Maryland Extension Service; Department of Natural Resources (DNR); Maryland Department of Agriculture; DNR Forestry; Maryland Department of the Environment (MDE) Water Management Administration.

- **4. Provide a detailed sketch of the property, including location of burn site.** Attach a property sketch or submit a detailed drawing of the property on page 3 (#18).
- 5. Name of Owner: Provide name, phone number and mailing address of the owner/agent.
- 6. Read, sign and date the application.

License To Conduct An Open Fire

The application, once approved, becomes the official **License to Conduct an Open Fire**. This License must be posted on the property where the open burning is being conducted and must be shown to County and State officials upon request. 	10.10.4 Open Fires.			
	10.01.4.1 Permitted open fires shall be located not less than 50 ft (15 m) from any structure.			
	10.10.4.2 Recreational fires shall not be located within 25 ft (7.6 m) of a structure or combustible material unless contained in an approved manner.			
	10.10.4.4 Conditions that could cause a fire to spread to within 25 ft (7.6m) of a structure shall be eliminated prior to ignition.			
	10.10.5.1 Open recreational fires and cooking fires shall be constantly attended by a competent person until such fire is extinguished; and 10.10.5.2 This person shall have a garden hose connected to the water supply or other fire-extinguishing equipment readily available for use.			
	10.10.10 Discontinuance. The AHJ shall be authorized to require any fire to be immediately discontinued if the fire is determined to constitute a hazardous condition.
